A few statistics:

One out of every five students (20.2%) students report being bullied (National Center for Educational Statistics, 2019)

The reasons reported for being bullied reported most often by students include physical appearance, race/ethnicity, gender, disability, religion and sexual orientation.

One in five (20.9%) tweens (9-12 years old) has been cyberbullied, cyberbullied others or seen cyberbullying. (Purchin and Hinduia 2020)

49.8% of tweens (9 to 12 years old) has been cyberbullied, cyberbullied others, or seen cyberbullying.
